BEST GUESS prompted the pace two wide, seized command in upper stretch, dug in inside of FRONT ROW DEBBIE when that foe bid near the three-sixteenths pole, was headed, fought back inside, dueled to the wire and narrowly prevailed. FRONT ROW DEBBIE settled off the pace outside, came four wide into the lane, lugged in in upper stretch, bid outside of the winner near the three-sixteenths marker, led briefly, dueled outside through the rest of the lane and just missed. MIL MIL bobbled at the start, tracked the pace inside and was one-paced in the lane. CASH TIZ WONDERFUL was in range outside, bid in upper stretch then weakened. BRONZE VENUS settled off the pace along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and had a mild rally. REMEMBER ROSIE failed to menace while racing three wide. IN GOOD COMPANY was outrun while racing two wide. STRISCETTA broke inwardly, set the pace along the rail and retreated in the lane. ZEUS'S THUNDER chased the pace inside and tired in the lane. THISONISMINE played no factor while racing two wide. SHESELLSSANCTUARY was reluctant to load, broke slowly and was never involved. LADY CHANDLER chased the pace three wide,

stopped nearing the lane and was eased.

GIANT RED was off a bit slow, raced toward the rear two wide and rallied belatedly. SAY HEY KID chased the pace two wide and lacked a closing bid. KILTED COWBOY saved ground off the pace, angled out nearing the lane and lacked the needed rally. BIG BEN raced far back inside early and passed tiring rivals. SMACK DOWN had brief speed inside. MOSTLY MOZART chased the pace three wide and came up empty in the lane. OUTSIDE

IN was outrun outside. MUSICAL SCORE set the pace along the inside and retreated through the stretch. PROSPECT ROAD fought the bit early, raced two wide and played no factor.
