JOUST stalked the pace two wide, bid while still in hand in upper stretch, cleared in midstretch and widened under confident handling. CLEARLY CLAIRE set the pace along the rail, responded to the winner's challenge in upper stretch, was no match for that foe but held well for the place. TAPANEL settled off the pace toward the outside, angled in in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain the show. ENGLISH DANCER dropped back to last early, saved ground, angled out near the three-eighths pole and improved her position outside. TALEOFTHEPRINCESS chased the pace inside and came up empty. LEGALLINI never threatened while racing three wide. VALENTINE ROSIE stalked the pace three wide and retreated in the lane. CAROLINA COURAGE played no factor while racing two wide. BEHOLD THE QUEEN broke a bit slowly, raced well back inside, steadied in traffic near the five-sixteenths marker, angled out and lacked a rally. QUE HANSEN was outrun inside. SUNSET GABLES chased the pace three and four wide and stopped nearing the lane. PERFECT GIANT had brief speed two wide.

NEILINGER broke a bit awkwardly, bobbled soon after, advanced three wide around the turn, split rivals near the three-sixteenths pole and rallied to narrow much of the gap. MO'S LOVE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace three wide, shifted further out in upper stretch and rallied for the show. SASHAY saved ground off the pace and rallied belatedly. BIG ISLAND BLONDE stalked the pace three wide and came up empty. LONG ROAD was bumped at the start, steadied early, advanced four wide and flattened out late. C'EST BON saved ground to no avail. BRUISED ORANGE prompted the pace two wide and retreated through the lane. SONG SUNG TRUE was outrun while racing two wide. KITTEN DANCE was bumped at the start, raced two wide and played no further factor. EASTERN MISCHIEF checked early and made little impact while saving ground. NORTHERN MICHIGAN chased the pace inside and tired.
