HEAVENLY KINGDOM raced up close early while wide, was shuffled back along the turn, came again nearing the lane, swung into the six path entering the lane, took over command and edged clear in the final stages. SHY stalked the pace early along the inside, angled off the rail in the turn, made a bid in the stretch from the inside but did not have enough in the late stages. LOVEMELIKEYOUDO was back early on, fanned into the five path in the turn, rallied into the lane, made a late bid three wide and was gaining in the final stages. ROLLOVER RISK tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn, had no room in the upper stretch, made a late bid four wide with a mild gain in the final stages. ETTALUSIVE chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch run. PRINCESS PRADO was on the inside in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. MARTLET broke slowly, swung into the six path in the turn. SHEZAPPEALING was never a threat. IRON LILLY was done early. ONE DOLLAR set the pace early, was on the inside entering the lane and gave way late.

SHIP DISTURBER was allowed to settle toward the inside, angled out entering the stretch, quickened once straightened, reeled in the leaders swiftly and drew away. HOLLYWOOD TALENT was away in good order, angled in to set the pace, was collared nearing the furlong marker, fought on but was unable to resist the winner. MAN OF STATURE broke a bit slow, looped into contention five wide, engaged HOLLYWOOD TALENT a furlong out, continued on well but was unable to bridge the gap. FAVORITE COACH settled in hand, tucked in to save ground, got through but failed to make headway through the drive. CURLINO was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild bid, was fanned out further in the final furlong and went evenly. PERFECT COMIC was close up three deep, drifted out some in the drive and weakened. MANO FOX was close up along the inside, drifted out and bumped HANDSOME JACK down the hill, was within reach for a half and tired. BETTER WATCH OUT contended off of the inside, was bumped and checked hard when HANDSOME JACK was forced out down the hill, dropped well back and passed only the tiring ones. UTMOST INTENSITY was close up three wide to the stretch and faltered between runners. HANDSOME JACK was forwardly placed off of the inside, was bumped and checked hard down the hill when MANO FOX came out, veered out bumping BETTER WATCH OUT and showed little thereafter.

KING VALERO steadied along early on from the inside, altered widest nearing the lane, fanned into the nine path entering the lane, rallied down the lane, made a bid three wide, drove past and cleared the field in the final stages. SOUPER SMART pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, continued the bid down the lane but hung in the late stages. HALLIE'S HERO set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. TARANTO stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. SAVOUR THE MOMENT tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. GOOD OFFENSE broke slowly and trailed the field early on, angled off the rail in the turn and moved up in the stretch. FINISHED was done early. STORM PEAK never menaced. SCHOENHARDT was never a threat. ONEJUMP was through after a half. DREAMING OF J C broke from the gate then quickly taken up, fanned into the five path in the turn. INDIAN INTERPRETER was never a factor.

COCO CHANNEL stalked the pace, launched a bold bid between runners entering the stretch, kept on well but wasn't quite good enough. FULL OF JOY was allowed to settle, made a sweeping move six wide, loomed large entering the stretch, continued on well but was unable to bridge the gap. DREAMCALL broke slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a late rally but was left with too much to do. NEVER GROW OLD was allowed to settle, moved up five wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. RED DANE (ITY) broke a step slow, settled in hand, closed the gap through the second turn, kept on well but failed to make headway. FREEDOM set the pace off of the inside to the stretch and gave way. PROMISE OF SPRING was forwardly placed along the inside, contested the issue to the final furlong and wilted. MEISTER LEGEND contended between rivals but lacked a response when called upon. MANY WATERS was unhurried, tucked in to save ground, got through to make a late rally, but was bottled up late and steadied nearing the wire. JEREMIAH JEWEL was close up three wide through the second turn and tired. UNION WAY failed to respond. KAUAI MOMENTS contended between horses, but stopped leaving the second turn.
