MONGOLIAN SHOPPER set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn then drew off late in the stretch and was geared down to the wire. WILD ABOUT IRENE stalked the pace early along the inside, angled off the rail in the turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch run. ANGEL CHOIR tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the upper stretch but weakened late in the drive. ENDLESS THYME broke thru the gate in the pre-start, chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch run. CRACK YOUR WHIP was back early on, angled off the rail in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. MERCER SLOUGH was well placed early, shifted into the three path in the turn and was empty late. BANDI'S GAL was done early. NORTHERN SCREAMER was never a threat. DULCE DE LECHE was through after a half. PRECISELY PONTI broke slowly and trailed the field throughout.

TIGERS RULE settled in hand, ranged up four wide, came to level terms a furlong out, wore down HONEY DONT and edged clear. HONEY DONT tracked three wide, bid between horses, fought on gamely but was unable to resist the winner. DISCOVERED set the pressured pace toward the inside, but weakened slightly during the drive and settled for the show. REALITY QUEEN was close up three deep, came four wide to make a bold bid, but flattened in the final furlong. CASH KITTEN was allowed to settle, circled five wide and was making up ground. JACKTASTIC was allowed to settle, advanced between horses on the turn to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. KEY TO QUALITY moved up along the inside, but came up empty midway through the turn and faded. ORBIT EARTH failed to respond. MUSIAL broke a bit slow, tucked in to save ground, but lacked a response when called upon. OVERCRITICIZED showed little. BURTON was never a factor.

LOVE ON TIDES was unhurried early along the inside, angled off the rail in the turn, made a bid from the inside near the eighth pole, altered out four wide nearing the sixteenth pole and edged clear in the final stages. KAYLEN'S REVENGE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn, made a bid nearing the eighth pole, was on the inside nearing the sixteenth pole but did not have enough in the final stages. CURVYMISSMILLER broke a bit slow and trailed the field early on, fanned into the eight path in the turn, rallied in the stretch and made a bid but flattened out late in the drive.
